Emarie Greathouse is our youngest daughter. She is the baby of our 6 amazing kids. Clinton and I both graduated from Artesia and we have a true love for the City of Champions and the support this community provides. In November of 2021, after searching for what was "wrong" with Emarie, we had a genetic panel tested and she was diagnosed with a rare genetic mutation, CACNA1A. While finally receiving a diagnosis seemed to be a huge accomplishment, the lack of knowledge and resources of this diagnosis left us just as lost as before the diagnosis. The only thing we were sure of was what symptoms this can cause: CACNA1A can cause a variety of scary and potentially irreversible symptoms. While this mutation affects everyone differently, Emarie's condition first presented as episodic seizures and episodic ataxia (loss of bodily function). Her disease is so rare that there is no name. It is simply known by the name of the mutated gene – CACNA1A.

In the world of rare diseases, patient advocacy groups play a key role in supporting families and connecting researchers to a disease. CACNA1A Foundation is a parent-led, non-profit dedicated to aggressively funding medical research in order to find targeted treatment options and a cure for those with CACNA1A variants.

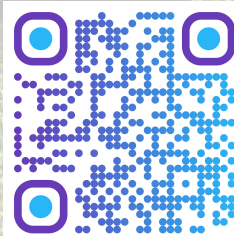

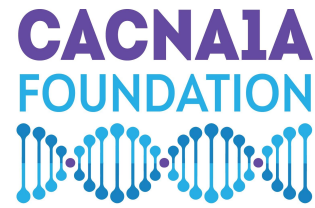

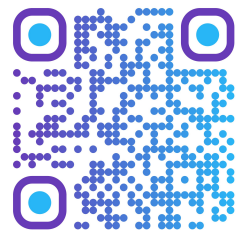
